Thanks to Mrs. Schreiner, the 8th Grade Class and Student Council for your continuing support, and to the students and Assumption Academy for this wonderful tradition.













Yoga mats for weekly adult exercise classes are also a part of the package which was underwritten by the Leprechauns so the Playhouse would have more opportunity to provide purposeful programs for the adults, the children, and their families. Everyone enjoyed pizza from Pizza BOGO, as well as gelato from The Sweet Spot, where Clementine's mother watched the birth of the Playhouse over the past 2 years.

...there were smiles on every face at the event; a two piece band, The Baker's Basement, added to the festive time that flew by. "No one ever wants to go home, because it is such an opportunity to just have fun," commented one of the volunteers.

The board members and volunteers have worked very hard over the past 3 years. The first 18 months were spent gathering interest and support, raising substantial funds, and finally, a little over a year ago, they officially opened the Lakewood Playhouse, the first in Ohio. The walls are beautifully painted in bright colors, the teens enjoy their own space where they can hang out in Club GiGi's, there is a Get Fit Gym where they enjoy the new basketball hoops, and the Learning Labs offer literacy and math tutoring. Speech therapy is on its way and is expected to launch in the fall!

Over 120 families from many parts of northeast Ohio have already benefitted from the therapeutic and educational programs, connecting with each other and providing their children an opportunity to achieve their Best of All! We wanted to thank you for our wish trip. From the moment we left home the trip was truly magical.


