



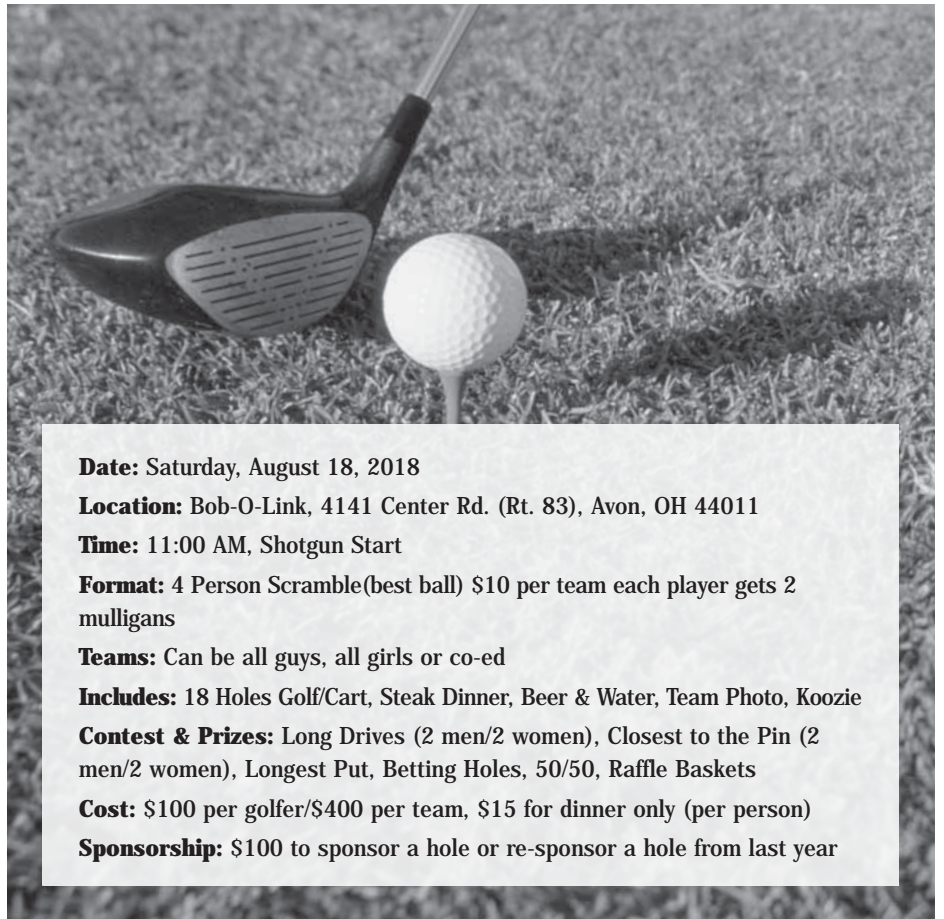

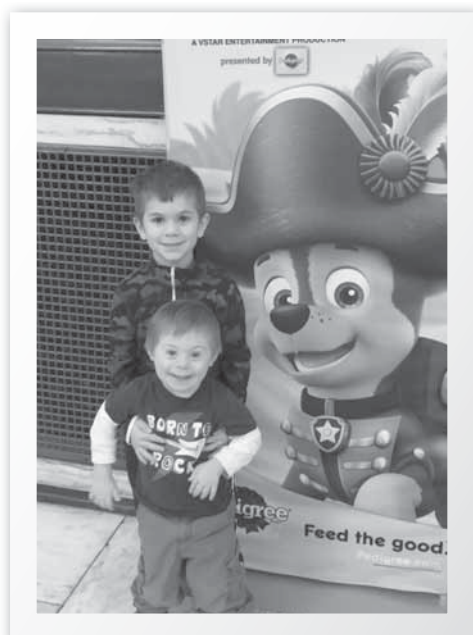
of \$7,276.00. That’s an amazing amount of money. Sign up information is elsewhere in this newsletter, or on our website at www.leprechaunfoundation.org.

We granted many wishes for single moms trying to get back on their feet with very sick children. We bought one mother a new stove because she did not have one.

We bought another family new bedroom furniture for her very ill son who was sleeping on the floor; it was a wonderful Mickey Mouse bed with all the Accessories.

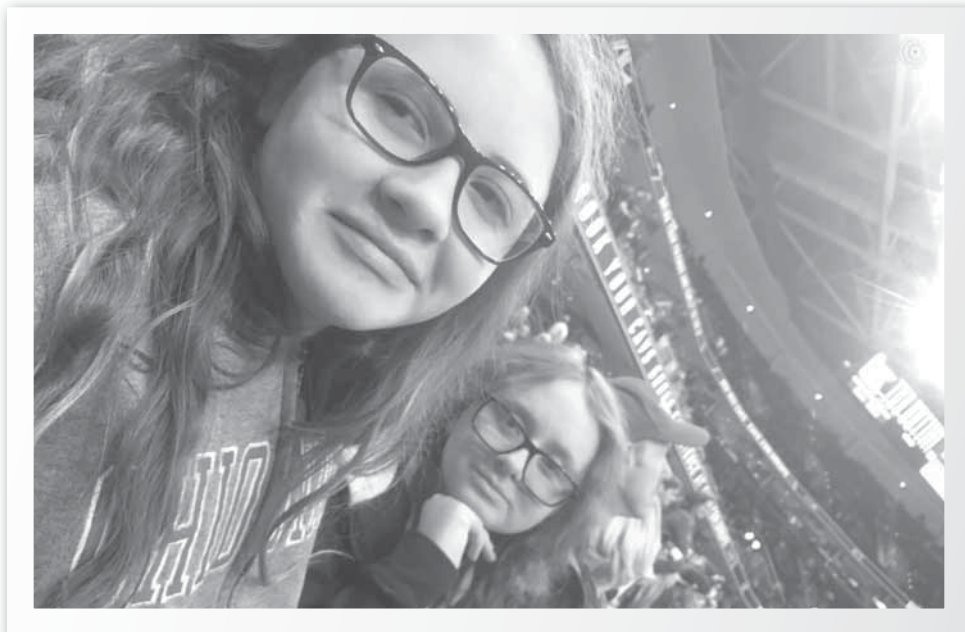
At Christmas time we purchased many beds for sick children that were either sleeping on the floor or on blow up mattresses. Actually, we buy beds for sick children all year long.

We sent a young adult (we do wishes for young adults that are still in Pediatrics) to shoot around at a Cavs game. He had the

chance to meet many of the players and had a great time. He has a brain tumor, has had surgery and he is on his second round of chemo. We provide Cavs tickets year round allowing many sick children to enjoy games all season long.

One group of sick children that are sometimes forgotten are the toddlers suffering from life threatening illness, a night out with friends or family gives them hope to go on. So in the last year we have sent many families to see the "Peppa

Pig" show live and the "Paw Patrol "show live. This May we have 30 tickets to send children ages 6-12 to an interactive family day at Playhouse Square featuring the characters from the Wizard of Oz, there will be activities for the whole family. This is a great way for families of all these little ones to forget their problems for a day. ❁
